POLICY NO. 7.03

TITLE: SAFETY AND TRAFFIC CONTROL

LEGAL AUTHORITY: FLORIDA STATUTE 1001.64

OFFICE OF PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITY: VICE PRESIDENT FOR
ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES

The president shall establish procedures for the orderly control of traffic, safety, and well-being of people, protection of property, and for emergency and disaster situations.

- A. The president may establish regulations, including a uniform fine procedure for violations of the established regulations, and erect directive signs to cover the use and parking of motor vehicles at all campuses and centers.
- B. The College does not assume responsibility for injuries and losses resulting from incidents/accidents occurring on or within College facilities, including loss of personal property, unless it is determined that the College is directly responsible for the accident/incident due to actions or inactions of College employees while engaged in assigned work activities.
