Nursing assistants work under the supervision of a licensed practical nurse (LPN) or registered nurse (RN) to assist patients with personal care, mobility, nutrition, hydration, maintaining a safe environment, and collecting basic patient data. They are employed by outpatient clinics, hospitals, and long-term care facilities. Students are responsible for the cost of drug screening, medical exams, and immunizations. Upon successful completion of this course, you will earn the 90 hours of Introduction to Health Care and 75 hours of Nursing Assistant, thus acquiring technical and academic knowledge needed for employability and for further education advancement in Health Science careers. Textbooks and workbook required and are available for purchase in the SFSC Bookstore. *Textbook: Nursing Assisting: A Foundation in Caregiving, 5th Edition*- D. Students are encouraged to attend CPR training on Saturday., Sept. 19 at the Hardee Campus. You must pre-register for the CPR course by calling 863.784.7405 and providing CRN 13971. - All males born after Dec. 31, 1959 must meet Selective Service registration requirements
