Entry Level Driver Training

(Type of training needed depends on current level of experience. See below to determine your training path.)

A. With Experience

Definition: Must have at least 160-hours of *verifiable* behind the wheel experience

 Training: Will need to take ELDT online training and 16 hours of in-person refresher to prepare for exam.

B. No Experience

Definition: No prior experience driving or some experience but unable to provide required verifiable BTW experience.

 Training: Will need to take 160 hours of training to prepare for exam.

Stats from a local partner:

The average first year income is \$51,000 - \$60,000. Drivers receive 1.5 days off for every week they are out on the road (minimum three weeks out), so for three weeks they can stay home four to five days. Drivers that go back on the road in two or three days will earn a salary of \$60,000.

Commercial License Permit (CLP), DOT Physical, & Drug Screen

Steps to Enroll: Must follow the steps in the specified order. A valid Class E driver's license is required to start the process.

Step 1 - Tuition Assistance

Connect with SFSC at 863-784-7033 to discover available funding opportunities. If you meet the eligibility requirements, you may be able to attend for

Step 2 - Medical Requirement

(Email CDL @southflorida.edu a copy of your MedCard to let us know you completed step two)

Get a DOT physical examination for Commercial Drivers Medical Certification which is required prior to receiving your temporary driving permit. MediTest, 1350 E. Main St., Suite C1, Bartow, FL 33830. Call for appointment 863-533-7484. Cost for SFSC students or prospective student is \$70. To get this rate, you must email CDL@southflorida.edu for a form. If using a different provider other than suggested, please make sure to ask if they are authorized to perform a DOT physical. Must be done by a provider that is authorized to do DOT physicals.

IMPORTANT: Do not take drug screening at this time. Drug test is done in step 5.

Step 3 - Earn CLP from DMV

(Email CDL @southflorida.edu a copy of your Permit to let us know you completed step three)

Successfully complete exam at DMV to earn your Certified Learner's Permit (CLP).

There are three parts to the DMV exam:

1st test is General Knowledge and it will cover Sections 1,2,3,11,12, and 13 of the handbook.

2nd test is Air Brakes and it will cover Section 5 of the handbook.

3rd test is Combination Vehicle and will cover Section 6 of the handbook.

Review the CDL Handbook which you can download to your phone or personal computer, SECTION 1 (flhsmv.gov).

Once you pass all three portions, you will obtain your Class A Certified Learner's Permit and it is valid for one year.

Step 4—Clearinghouse

(Email CDL @southflorida.edu and let us know you completed step four)

Step 4 MUST be done prior to step 5. *Must wait 14 business days after permit issue date. Are you registered in Clearinghouse with your employer? If yes, skip this step and let us know. If you are NOT registered, click this link and register https://clearinghouse.fmcsa.dot.gov/ follow the steps to create an account. Use your personal email, not recommended to use college or work email that may become inactive. Select language and create 12 character password (you will need to remember it). Select phone option in order to receive security codes when logging in. Enter security code sent to your phone, submit, agree and continue. Select Student Driver and click Register as a Student Driver as your role. Enter your contact information and select email as preferred contact method. Designate South Florida State College as your (C/TPA), select Report Violations and Report RTD Information and next. Enter current CDL Permit and then Verify. SFSC will run a query in Clearinghouse after SFSC receives your drug test results. Please accept our query when you receive notification. You must enter your Commercial License Permit (CLP) number and add South Florida State College as your C/TPA to finalize account setup. It is IMPORTANT to complete this step PRIOR to getting your drug test.

Step 5 - 10-Panel Drug Screening

(<u>Email CDL@southflorida.edu</u> and let us know you completed step five)
Get a DOT Drug screen. Please Read! MediTest, 1350 E. Main St., Suite C1, Bartow, FL 33830. Call for appointment at **863-533-7484**. Cost for SFSC students or prospective student is \$65. You will need a form from SFSC prior to drug screen. For the form, email us at cdl@southflorida.edu or stop by 200 US HWY 27 S., Avon Park, If you choose a different laboratory, make sure that they will send the results to a third party prior to screening. Results will need to be emailed to cdl@southflorida.edu. Any student that does not pass their drug screening will not be accepted into the CVD program. All fees paid at the time of screening are non-refundable.

Step 6 - Register in Employ Florida

(Email CDL@southflorida.edu and let us know you completed step six)

1. Go to www.employflorida.com in the browser bar. Under the Username and Password boxes, click on Not Registered?


2. Under Option 3 - Create a User Account, click on Individual.

3. You will be shown a Privacy Agreement explaining the specific uses of your information.

4. You will be asked to enter information starting with a Username and Password. Your Password must be at least 8 characters long and no more than 16 characters long, and must use at least one of each of these: uppercase letter, lowercase letter, number, and special character (options: # @ \$ % ^ . ! * _). No spaces are allowed.

5. All questions with an asterisk (*) are mandatory. For instructions, please read the captions to the right of the area you need to fill in.

If the instructions are not followed, entries will not be saved.



Contact SFSC Corporate Training at **863-784-7033** and touch base with a representative to make sure you are ready to register and pay for the course. Email: CDL@southflorida.edu.

Step 8 - ONLY for Refresher candidates: Must complete CDL Theory prior to skills and road training.

SFSC will email you the instructions and link to take the online course. Once you complete all quizzes and scored a minimum of 80%, email CDL@southflorida.edu to schedule your training that will prepare you for the CDL exam.

(In the 4-week class, theory training is included In course fee. Students receive login info on first week of class.)

Prior to beginning the training and exam, a Commercial Learner's Permit (CLP) from the DMV is required along with registering online with CDL clearinghouse and a DOT physical and drug screen (see steps on previous page). Cost includes tuition and two attempts at the CDL Class A exam. For more information, visit southflorida.edu/cdl. Must be fluent in English (speaking, reading, understanding), and must be 18+ of age to take the course. Scholarships are available for those who qualify for the training.

CDL Refresher Training and Exam: CLASS A, B or C

Business to Business ONLY! This is for businesses that need employees prepared for the state exam. The employee must have a minimum of a 160 verifiable hours behind the wheel. SFSC is a State of Florida-approved testing facility for the Commercial Drivers License (CDL) skills test, consisting of three parts: the state-mandated, pre-trip inspection, covering 170 parts of the vehicle that must be checked; the basic controls skills test; and the road course. Applicants who pass all three parts receive a Class A, B or C CDL. Participants may use their own vehicle/trailer or one provided by SFSC. The refresher training is a 33-hour program focuses on CDL theory and test preparation. Prior to beginning the training and exam, all steps on previous page must be completed.

Training Fees for Refreshers: \$1,900 (CDL theory and 2-day test prep).

Testing Fees: Full exam (all 3 parts)—\$500; Partial exam—\$350. To schedule, call 863-784-7033.
