

INCREASED SANITIZATION PRACTICES

- Custodial staff will be cleaning and disinfecting high-touch surfaces throughout our buildings
 regularly throughout the day, with a focus on door handles, elevators, drinking fountains, stair
 bannisters, and restrooms. High volume restrooms and large lab areas will also be disinfected
 after hours using a backpack sprayer.
- Nearly 100 hand sanitizer dispensers will be permanently installed in corridors of buildings and
 in all areas where students, employees, and visitors travel. Lobbies and other large open areas
 will have no-touch hand sanitizers in place near entrances for added convenience.
- Disinfecting wipes will be provided to faculty to use in classrooms/labs on high-touch surfaces. Students can assist in sanitizing their workspace area as they arrive for class.
- Infrared no-touch thermometers have been provided to Campus Security, deans, campus directors, and in most buildings to assist with assessing a student or employee's health status. A fever (100.4 or higher) is cause to require the individual to leave campus ASAP and seek medical assistance.
- In the event of a positive COVID-19 exposure, all areas in which an exposure occurred will be shut down until such time that they are thoroughly disinfected and cleaned.
