- **40 hour Introductory Child Care Training**
  - SFSC offers as a face to face class – usually meets on Mon/Wed or Tues/Thurs
  - SFSC course fee: \$199.99 for the 40 hour class
  - Training taken at SFSC includes all 6 manuals, resource materials and study guides
  - Length of course is approximately 1.5 months
  - Courses may be taken online through DCF ONLY not SFSC for more information visit [www.myflorida.com/childcare](http://www.myflorida.com/childcare)

- **FCCPC – Florida Child Care Professional Credential**
  - SFSC offers part I and II (total of 120 hours)
  - Length of each part/course are approximately 2 or 2.5 months in length
  - SFSC Course fee: \$300 *per class*
  - All FCCPC requirements must be completed prior to receiving a State issued certificate. For more information, please visit [www.myflorida.com/childcare](http://www.myflorida.com/childcare)
  - ***Some students may be able to qualify for a Staff Credential. If students meet the requirements they would not be required to take the FCCPC. For more information, please visit [www.myflorida.com/childcare](http://www.myflorida.com/childcare)***
- **Directors Credential**
  - SFSC offers the Program Management course as an online/hybrid course. This format is mostly online with a few face to face meetings as assigned by the instructor
  - This course is a non-credit course and it meets the DCF requirements
