Participants will learn the principles of acrylic painting at the beautiful Hotel Jacaranda in downtown Avon Park. This class is for beginning and intermediate students. Students will paint subjects of their choice or work on a project with the instructor. Usually, two paintings are completed during the session. To register, call **863-784-7405**. The following supplies will be needed:

Most Used Paint Colors: Burnt Sienna (Winsor-Newton Artist Acrylic is preferred by instructor); Burnt Umber, Hookers Green, Cobalt Blue, Yellow Ochre, Hansa Yellow Light, Titanium White (Large Tube). Instructor encourages the use of Artist Grade Paint, such as Liquitex Professional, Golden or Winsor-Newton Artist Acrylic.

Brushes: No. 4 Hog Hair Fan (also called Bristle). Need soft synthetic for all of the following brushes: No. 3 or 4 Liner, No. 2 Flat, No. 2 or Smaller Script Liner plus any others you like to use.

Optional Paint Colors: Cadmium Red Dark, Cadmium Orange, Black, Dioxazine Purple, Cobalt Green, Green Gold, Yellow Orange Azo, Burnt Orange and any other colors you wish to use.

Other supplies: white pastel pencil or chalk, No. 2 pencil, eraser, Q-tips, natural wool sponges, paper towels, palette knife, small spray bottle, palette and/or palette paper and two 16" x 20" canvases.

Students will learn how to mix colors and apply common oil techniques to create a painting. This class is for students with any level of experience. The following supplies will be needed:

One 16" x 20" canvas.

Basic Oil Paints: Cadmium Red or Vermillion, Cerulean Blue, Alizarin Crimson, Burnt Sienna, Lemon Yellow or Hansa Yellow, Burnt Umber, Yellow Ochre, Ivory Black, Sap Green, Titanium White, Ultramarine Blue.

Brushes: Flat brushes, small, medium and large (#2, #6, #12 or similar), Round brushes, small (for details) and larger rounds, sizes #6 or #8, Soft mop (blender) brush.

Other items: Paper towels, Oil medium (as Liquin or Grumbacher, Palette paper or wooden palette, Oil Painting Medium) for thinning, Solvent (odorless mineral spirits), paint, Palette knife for mixing paints, Container for your solvent.

Water Color Painting: Absolute Beginning - \$65

Water Color Painting Supply List:

PAPER: 140-lb Arches Cold Press Watercolor paper, 11 x 14 or larger, single sheets or block.

PAINTS (*basic dozen*): New Gamboge or Gamboge Hue, Cadmium Red, Aureolin Yellow, Permanent Rose, Cobalt Blue, Cadmium Orange, Ultramarine Blue, Burnt Sienna, Faience Blue, Sap Green, Cerulean Blue, Violet/Purple.

BRUSHES: Flats - size 1/2 flat, Rounds - sizes #6, #8 and #14.

OTHER ITEMS: Paper towels, Spray bottle, Board for support masking tape or painter's tape, #2 pencil, facial tissue, kneaded eraser, sponge.
