FALL 2019 ADMISSION CHECKLIST – DENTAL HYGIENE PROGRAM

TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR ADMISSION TO THE FALL 2019 SFSC DENTAL HYGIENE PROGRAM, YOU MUST:

- ☐ Complete an online [General Student Application](#) to South Florida State College if you are a new student or if you have not taken classes within the last year by **April 12, 2019**.
- ☐ Submit *official* [high school transcripts](#) or [GED transcript](#) to the SFSC Admissions Office by **April 12, 2019**. If you are currently in high school, you must be 18 or older and have your diploma before the first day of Fall 2019 classes.
- ☐ Submit *official* [college transcripts](#) from all other colleges you have attended to the SFSC Admissions Office by **April 12, 2019**.
- ☐ Have completed the following prerequisite courses (minimum grade of 'C' per course & prerequisite GPA of 2.75) by the **end of the 2019 SPRING term (May 6, 2019)**:
 - BSC 1085C – Human Anatomy and Physiology I (4 credit hours)
 - BSC 1086C – Human Anatomy and Physiology II (4 credit hours)
 - CHM 1020 – Introducing General Chemistry (3 credit hours)
 - CHM 1020L – Introducing General Chemistry Lab (1 credit hour)
 - ENC 1101 – Freshman English I (3 credit hours)
 - MAC 1105 – College Algebra (3 credit hours)
 - MCB 2010C – Microbiology (4 credit hours)
 - * All sciences courses must have been taken within 5 years of application to the program.
 - * All remedial courses must be completed to be eligible for college-level courses.
- ☐ Complete 40 hours of observation/working in a *general* dentist office/clinic by **April 12, 2019**. The [Dental Hygiene Observation Hours form](#) must be completed and submitted online with your dental hygiene program application.
- ☐ Complete an online [Dental Hygiene program application](#) between **January 14, 2019 - April 12, 2019**.

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FALL 2019 ACCEPTANCE REQUIREMENTS – DENTAL HYGIENE PROGRAM

ONCE ACCEPTED INTO THE FALL 2019 SFSC DENTAL HYGIENE PROGRAM, YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO:

- ☐ Create an account with CastleBranch and submit the following (forms will be provided after acceptance into program):
 - Student Health History
 - Acknowledgement of Privacy Practices
 - Dental Hygiene Program Performance Standards
 - Physical Examination
 - Dental Student Immunizations/Titers
 - Tdap (within last 10 years)
 - Hepatitis B (This is a series of three vaccines, followed by a titer to prove immunity)
 - TB (PPD) skin test or chest x-ray (due annually)
 - Hepatitis C Antibody Titer
 - Dental Examination

- ☐ Background Check

- ☐ Current American Heart Association (AHA) Healthcare Provider CPR Certification

Admission to the dental hygiene program is contingent upon submission of satisfactory results of a federal criminal background check. If accepted into the dental hygiene program, information on health forms, and how to obtain the background check will be provided.

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
