TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR ADMISSION TO THE FALL 2019 SFSC RADIOGRAPHY PROGRAM, YOU MUST:

- □ Complete an online <u>General Student Application</u> to South Florida State College if you are a new student or if you have not taken classes within the last year by April 12, 2019.
- Submit *official* <u>high school transcripts</u> or <u>GED transcript</u> to the SFSC Admissions Office by April 12, 2019. If you are currently in high school, you must be 18 or older and have your diploma before the first day of Fall 2019 classes.
- □ Submit *official* <u>college transcripts</u> from all other colleges you have attended to the SFSC Admissions Office by April 12, 2019.
- □ Have completed the following prerequisite courses (minimum grade of 'C' per course & prerequisite GPA of 2.75) by the end of the 2019 SPRING term (May 6, 2019):
 - BSC 1085C Human Anatomy and Physiology I (4 credit hours)
 - ENC 1101 Freshman English I (3 credit hours)
 - MAC 1105 College Algebra (3 credit hours)
 - * All sciences courses must have been taken within 5 years of application to the program.
 - * All remedial courses must be completed to be eligible for college-level courses.
- Complete 8 hours of observation/working in a radiologic facility by April 12, 2019. The <u>Radiography Program Observation Verification</u> form must be completed and submitted online with your radiography program application.
- Complete an online <u>Radiography Program Application</u> between January 14, 2019 April 12, 2019.

FALL 2019 ACCEPTANCE REQUIREMENTS – RADIOGRAPHY PROGRAM

ONCE ACCEPTED INTO THE FALL 2019 SFSC RADIOGARPHY PROGRAM, YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO:

- □ Create an account with CastleBranch and submit the following (forms will be provided after acceptance into program):
 - Student Health History
 - Acknowledgement of Privacy Practices
 - Physical Examination
 - Dental Student Immunizations/Titers
 - Tdap (within last 10 years)
 - MMR (titer or two doses)
 - Hepatitis B (This is a series of three vaccines, followed by a titer to prove immunity)
 - TB (PPD) skin test or chest x-ray (due annually)
 - Hepatitis C Antibody Titer
 - o Varicella Antibody Titer
 - Hepatitis B Antibody Titer
 - o Influenza Vaccination
- □ Background Check
- □ Ten Panel Drug Screen
- □ Current American Heart Association (AHA) Healthcare Provider CPR Certification
- □ Physical and Technical Abilities Required of a Competent Radiographer

All candidates accepted into the radiography program must submit to an official criminal history background check and drug screening. Some providers of clinical experiences do not allow individuals with certain types of criminal history into their facilities, in accordance with Florida Statute 468.3065. You may review an explanation of Program Disqualification Due to Past Convictions or contact the Florida Department of Health for more information.
