To qualify you must be a resident of the counties they serve, must be 18 years of age or older, meet U.S. Citizenship requirements or hold current permanent resident alien card, all males born after Dec. 31, 1959 must meet Selective Service registration requirements, and household income must fall within specific program guidelines.
