**TITLE:** COURSE POLICY STATEMENT (SYLLABUS)

**LEGAL AUTHORITY: FLORIDA STATUTE 1001.64** 

**OFFICE OF PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITY**: VICE PRESIDENT FOR ACADEMIC AFFAIRS AND STUDENT SERVICES

All faculty who teach college and career credit courses, both full-time and adjunct, will provide each student in his/her class with a syllabus (course policy statement) on the first day that the student is in the class, in accordance with the following provisions:

- A. The syllabus will consist of, but not necessarily be limited to:
  - 1. A description of the course and student learning outcomes content
  - 2. Instructor's grading/evaluation policy
  - 3. Instructor's class attendance policy
  - 4. When applicable, provide information on state requirements for general education
  - 5. Cheating/plagiarism policy
  - 6. Policies on visitors in the classroom and religious holiday observance
  - 7. Students with disabilities procedures

These will be strictly adhered to by the instructor for the entire term.

- B. The course description in the College Catalog, together with the approved course syllabus and student learning outcomes, constitute an agreement between the College and the student.
- C. The instructor will address all such student learning outcomes within the span of the course.
