I. Purpose:

To describe graduation fee requirements

II. Procedure:

- A. Official College diplomas will be provided to students satisfactorily completing the requirements for B.A.S., B.S., A.A., and A.S. degrees upon payment of the graduation application fee as set by the South Florida State College (SFSC) District Board of Trustees (DBOT).
- B. A certificate of completion will be awarded to students satisfactorily completing the requirements of occupational certificate and college credit programs upon payment of the graduation application fee as set by the DBOT.
- C. The Florida Board of Education provides a state of Florida high school diploma to students who satisfactorily pass the GED tests upon payment of the graduation application fee as set by the DBOT. Fees for test administration are to be paid prior to testing.
