Course meets Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday 5:30—9:30 p.m. and some Saturdays 8 a.m.—5 p.m. Saturday dates are Sept. 18, Oct. 2, Oct. 16, Nov. 6, Nov. 20, Dec. 4, Dec. 18, Jan. 8, Jan. 22, Feb. 5, Feb. 19, March 5, March 19, April 2, April 23, and May 7, 2022. This program offers classroom instruction with hands-on laboratory experiences to teach students to weld. The course is designed so welders will be able to work and be successful in several different areas of welding such as construction, shop manufacturing, and fabrication using SMAW (stick) and gas welding. Students will be introduced to the inert gas-shielded welding methods (MIG & TIG). Upon completion, students have the opportunity to become a Certified Welder by the American Welding Society (AWS). Protective gear, tool kit, and AWS Certified Welder exam fee is included in the cost of the course (a \$965 value). 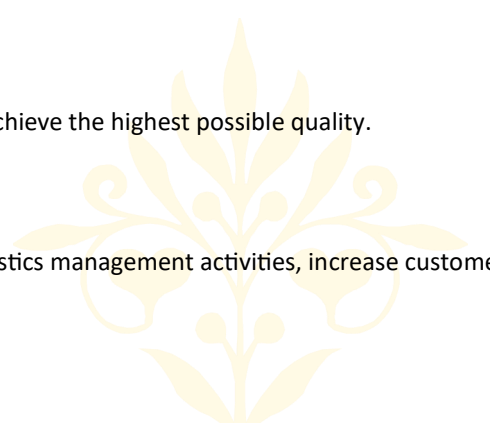

The following general requirements apply for scholarships for training services:

Must be a resident of DeSoto, Hardee, Highlands, or Okeechobee County.
Must be 18 years of age or older.
Meet U.S. Citizenship requirements or hold current Permanent Resident Alien Card.
All males born after December 31, 1959 must meet Selective Service registration requirements.
Household income falls within specific program guidelines.

You may also qualify if one of the following applies:

You are about to be or have been laid off from your job and are unlikely to return to the same or similar position; and you are eligible for, receiving, or have exhausted your reemployment compensation benefits.

You are a displaced homemaker no longer supported by the income of another family member and are unemployed or underemployed.

You are a former contract worker or self-employed individual who is unemployed due to current economic conditions.
