_____1. Complete an Associate in Arts (AA) degree or the equivalent, including all general education requirements and required Florida mandated common course prerequisites. Students with a minimum of 60 transferable hours, with all general education requirements and prerequisites met, may apply for admission.

2. Complete lower-division education prerequisite courses with grades of **C or higher**:

• EDF 1005 - Introduction to the Teaching Profession

_____3. Earn a cumulative grade point average of at least **2.5** on a 4.0 scale for all higher education classes.

_____4. Pass at least two subtests of the General Knowledge and miss less than 10 points on the failed subtests. To sign up for the General Knowledge Test, please go to the following website: http://www.fl.nesinc.com/

5. Demonstrate proficiency in foreign language. You may demonstrate proficiency in foreign language by completion of two years of high school instruction in the same foreign language or completion of a minimum of eight college-level credits in one foreign language, per Florida Statute 1007.262.

_____ 6. Complete an interview with the BSEE Lead Instructor.

_____ 7. Pass a background check to include fingerprinting and drug testing. At SFSC, this is only required after you are conditionally accepted. Background checks are conducted by a local school board and must completed by September 1. The cost is approximately \$100.
