BSETE Admission Requirements:

In addition to fulfilling the entrance requirements for college or a university, applicants for any state-approved BSETE degree program must meet the following requirements, consistent with Florida Statute 1004.04:

_____ 1. Complete an Associate in Arts (AA) degree or the equivalent, including all General Education requirements and required Florida-mandated common course prerequisites. Students with a minimum of 60 transferable hours, with all General Education requirements and prerequisites met, may apply for admission.

_____ 2. Complete lower-division education prerequisite courses with grades of **C or higher**:

- EDF 1005 - Introduction to the Teaching Profession

_____ 3. Earn a cumulative GPA of at least **2.5** on a 4.0 scale for all higher education classes

_____ 4. Pass at least two subtests of the General Knowledge Test and miss less than 10 points on the failed subtests. To sign up for the General Knowledge Test, please visit the following website: fl.nesinc.com/.

_____ 6. Pass a background check including fingerprinting and drug testing. At SFSC, this is only required after you are conditionally accepted. Background checks are conducted by a local school board and must be completed by Sept. 1. The cost is approximately \$100.

_____ 7. Fulfill the Civic Literacy requirement. This requirement includes successfully completing an approved course, and successfully completing an independent assessment.
