

**Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund**  
**Section 18004(a)(1) HEERF**

**The status of the HEERF funds dispersed to SFSC as of January 10, 2022:**

The form authorizing fund dispersal from the CARES Act Section 18004 (e), CRRSAA Section 314 (e), and ARP Section 2300 (a)(1) programs to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students was submitted to the Florida Department of Education on **April 13, 2020**.

The total amount of funds that SFSC has received from the Department of Education pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students  
**= \$5,928,149.00**

The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under the CARES Act, CRRSAA, and ARP programs as **January 10 = \$3,931,455.87**

The estimated total number of students at the institution that are eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CARES Act, CRRSAA, and ARP programs = **3,896**

The method(s) used by the SFSC to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they would receive under the CARES Act, CRRSAA, and ARP programs:

**STUDENT ELIGIBILITY**

The U.S. Department of Education has provided direction regarding who is eligible to receive emergency financial aid grants. Emergency financial aid grants are limited and will be disbursed to eligible students based on order of application received. SFSC is prioritized student with exceptional need. Students must meet the following criteria to qualify for the funds:

1. Students must be currently enrolled at SFSC and actively participating in your current classes.
2. Students must have completed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

3. Be making satisfactory academic progress

### **AWARD CRITERIA**

Distribution of awards is based on a student's Expected Family Contribution (EFC), calculated by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Award amounts vary as indicated by the chart below:
