Admission Requirements

The BAS-SM degree is an open access program available to you when you have successfully completed an associate degree or 60 college credit hours for transfer applicants. Additional requirements include:

- 1. Provide official transcripts from all previous educational institutions attended
- Demonstrate proficiency in foreign language through either the completion of two years of high school instruction of the same foreign language, *or* completion of two sequential college terms in a foreign language

Recommended Soft Skills

Communication – the ability to understand and be understood by others; to include communicating ideas to others, actively listening in conversations, giving and receiving critical feedback

Conflict Resolution – the process by which two or more parties reach a peaceful resolution to a dispute

Cooperation – the process of working together to the same end

Critical Thinking – the objective analysis of facts to form a reasonable judgement

Decision Making – the act of choosing between two or more courses of action leading to the solution of a problem using either intuition or a reasoned process or both

Dependability – the quality of being trustworthy and reliable

Emotional Intelligence – the capacity to be aware of, control, and express one's emotions and handle interpersonal relationships judiciously and empathetically

Leadership – the ability of an individual to lead or guide other individuals or teams
