- 3. Earn a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale for all higher education classes
- 4. Demonstrate proficiency in foreign language.
- 5. Demonstrate mastery of General Knowledge Test, GKT
- 6. Pass a background check to include fingerprinting and drug testing

Florida has a severe and growing teacher shortage. Districts had more than 4,000 advertised vacancies for classroom teachers. As of January 2020, midway through the school year, more than 2,440 teaching positions remained unfilled a 10% increase from January 2019.
