

Bright Futures Eligibility Appeal 2023-2024

Bright Futures provides an appeal process for students who do not meet academic progress requirements for renewal. Exceptions may be made when students fall below the minimum grade point average and/or credit hours required for a state award. Appeals may be filed when a student does not meet academic progress requirements due to one of two circumstances: verifiable illness or circumstance beyond student's control. The appeal documents must present a clear connection between the illness or emergency and the student's poor academic performance.
