Online Training:

Florida Child Care Professional Credential — FCCPC/CDA Equivalency (Initial certification):

The FCCPC Birth Through Five is a DCF department-approved training program that consists of a minimum of 120 hours of early childhood instruction and 480 contact hours with children ages birth through eight (8). Find an approved Birth Through Five FCCPC training provider.

Note: Currently SFSC only offers the FCCPC renewal course, not the initial certification.

Directors Credential (Initial certification):

According to the Florida Child Care Standards, every child care facility must have a director with a Director Credential. Pursuant to Section 402.305(2)(f), F.S., 65C-22.001(6), Florida Administrative Code
