Have you or a family member worked as a migrant or seasonal farmworker in the past 2 years?

If so, you may qualify to receive assistance with:

Training Costs Tuition Fees Personalized Counseling
Supplies College Applications Uniforms
Scholarship and Grant Applications Career and Skills Assessments
And Much More...

You may qualify if you meet the following criteria:

- U.S. Citizen, eligible Non-Citizen (Permanent Resident), or Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) recipient
- Males who are between the ages of 18-26 must be registered with Selective Service
- Receive public assistance (Food Stamps or TANF) or whose family income is less than 70% of the Lower Living Standard Income Level (See Table Below)
- You, your parents, or spouse received at least 50% of total earned income from Farm work.

Things you need to apply:

(may vary depending on individual circumstances):

- Photo ID or Driver's License
- Valid Social Security Card
- Birth Certificate or Permanent Resident Card or Employment Authorization Card
- Proof of Family Size: Income Taxes or Birth Certificates or a Family Bible
- Proof of Income for the last 24 Months: Check Stubs, W-2's, Letters from Employer, etc.
- Public Assistance Letter (food stamps)
