

## State Scholarship Eligibility Appeal 2025-2026

Bright Futures provides an appeal process for students who do not meet academic progress requirements for renewal. Appeals may be considered when a student falls below the required GPA and/or credit hours due to:

- A verifiable illness, or
- An extenuating circumstance beyond the student's control

Appeals must clearly demonstrate how the situation impacted academic performance. Supporting documents must be date-specific and directly related to the issue described in the appeal letter.
