This course will prepare an instructor for Commission certification as a High Liability Instructor in Vehicle Operations and instruct the CMS Law Enforcement Vehicle Operations Course in the Florida Basic Recruit Training Program or agency in-service. This competency-based course may be completed in less than 40 hours if all objectives, content, exercises, testing, and examinations are satisfied. Students must achieve a minimum score of 85% on the written exam and demonstrate 100% proficiency in all vehicle operation skills as required by CJSTC rules. No remediation is permitted for the written exam or proficiency demonstrations.
