SUBJECT: DUAL ENROLLMENT – EARLY COLLEGE STUDENT PERFORMANCE
CONTRACT

Pursuant to Florida Statute 1007.273, students who participate in Early College dual enrollment are required to sign a Performance Contract with specific requirements, which are included in this contract.

Early College Definition, per Florida Statute 1007.273(3)), is defined as “a structured high school acceleration program in which a cohort of students is enrolled full time in postsecondary courses toward an associate degree.” Eligible secondary students enroll in the college on a full-time basis. Full-time status is defined as:

- College Credit Track: A minimum of twelve (12) college credit hours per semester.
- Technical Track: A minimum of twenty-four (24) clock hours per week.

Technical Early Admission Eligibility Pursuant to F.S. 1007.271(11), participation in Technical Early Admission is strictly limited to students who have completed a minimum of four (4) semesters of full-time secondary enrollment, including studies undertaken in the ninth grade.
